Art Major: Participate in an art faculty critique before their senior year, three semester hours in Art History at the 300/400 level, ART 395 Portfolio and ART 495 Senior Exhibition, twelve semester hours of advanced graphic design courses to complete a concentration or 12 semester hours of approved art studio electives, and a senior group exhibition.

Remainder of the 120 hour degree is general electives of the student's choice.

- 1. Art majors must earn a grade of "C" or better in all art courses.
- 2. Any student wishing to continue in sequential art courses must have earned a grade of "C" in all designated prerequisites.
- 3. Transfer students must complete a Siena Heights library skills assessment.
