**MATH proficiency: Preferred MAT 143 or 174 (Statistics courses at SHU). SHU will accept MAT 104 or 135 for proficiency only. SHU will accept an equivalent Math course in Statistics at another university. SHU will accept up to 90 hours of transfer credit for the degree, toward liberal arts, and for elective hours within the 120 hours required by the baccalaureate degree.

Bachelor of Science in Nursing Degree Completion

The Bachelor of Science in Nursing Completion Degree for Registered Nurses (RN-BSN program) was designed for licensed RN's to earn a bachelor's degree in nursing. Students admitted to the RN-BSN program must have graduated from an accredited program of nursing ~ either a two year associate degree nursing program or a diploma degree hospital based program.

Requirements for the BSN degree and the Major in Nursing at Siena Heights University:

- A. Requirements for admission into the RN-BSN program:
 - 1. An unencumbered license to practice as a registered nurse (RN).
 - 2. Forty (40) semester hours of transfer credit in approved nursing courses.

- B. Program Requirements (24) semester hours -- each course 4 credits
 - 1. NUR 301* Transition to Professional Nursing (Online)
 - 2. NUR 375 Health Care of Communities and Vulnerable Populations
 - 3. NUR 380 Evidenced Based Research in Nursing Practice (Online)
 - 4. NUR 395 Health Policy and Informatics
 - 5. NUR 460 The Art of Ethical, Cultural, and Spiritual Nursing Practice
 - 6. NUR 480 Leadership & Health Care Organizations (Online)

- C. Cognate Requirements -- 6 semester hours: each course 3 credits
 - 1. Religious Studies or a Philosophy course taken at Siena.
 - 2. LAS401 Senior Seminar: Integrative Experience at Siena.

- D. Transfer credits approved by the Registrar up to 90 semester hours.

- E. Total semester hours for BSN Degree **120 semester hours**

- F. All students must apply and be accepted into the Nursing program before enrolling in courses.

- G. All students must meet SHU proficiency requirements in English and Mathematics.
