Students must have completed the Associate Degree from Washtenaw Community College. Total hours needed to graduate is 120 credits. Additional electives must be taken to reach the required number of hours for graduation. The recommendation is to take additional Child Studies and Behavior Studies Classes. Students must have a UM-Dearborn GPA of 2.5 or better overall, a 2.5 or better in Child Studies (Area I) and Behavioral Studies (Area II) to earn the Bachelors of General Studies degree (BGS) to graduate. At least 48 hours must be numbered 300 or above including 21 hours in College of Education, Health, & Human Services.
