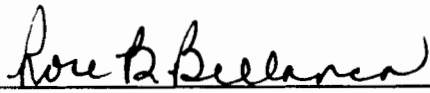

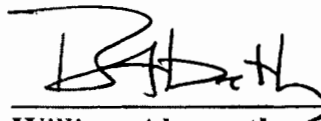
Article I Agreement on Principle

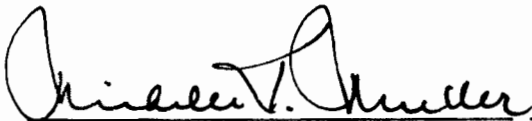
Washtenaw Community College (WCC) acknowledges that students, who choose to transfer from a non-credit program to a community college to earn a certificate or an associate's degree, should be provided with a smooth curriculum transition that minimizes duplication of coursework. Therefore, Washtenaw Community College acknowledges an articulation agreement for students who complete the WCC's Division of Contract Training/Workforce Development course **CIS 1017 - Career Readiness Course: IT including IC3 Certification** will be awarded 3 credits in **CIS 306 – CIS Elective**. CIS 306 meets the College's General Education requirement for Computer and Information Literacy. Both parties enter into this agreement as cooperating, equal partners, who shall maintain the integrity of their separate programs.

In order to have credit posted on their transcript students must complete the credit admission process and submit documentation of completion of their IC3 certification.

We, the representatives of **Washtenaw Community College** and **Washtenaw Community College's Division of Contract Training/Workforce Development**, agree to the terms of this agreement.
